

Information notice pursuant to Art. 13 of Reg. 679/2016/EU on the protection of personal data

The company ACS Srl (hereinafter "Controller"), as Data Controller, informs you, pursuant to Art. 13 of Reg. 679/2016/EU (hereinafter "GDPR") that your data will be processed with the following methods and for the following purposes:

Data subject to the Processing

The Controller processes personal, identification and non-specific data (such as name, surname, tax number, VAT number, e-mail, telephone number - hereinafter "personal data" or also "data") communicated by you in order to carry out the contractual performance.

Purpose of the Processing

Please note that your personal data are processed:

A. WITHOUT YOUR CONSENT (Art. 6 para.1 lett. b GDPR), for the following purposes

- To fulfil pre-contractual, contractual and tax obligations arising from existing relationships with you;
- To fulfil the obligations laid down by law, a regulation, the Community legislation or an order of the Authority;
- To exercise the rights of the Controller, such as the right of legal defence.

The duration of the processing is generally linked to the existing contract, while for some types of data and processing the duration is linked to the fulfilment of regulatory obligations.

B. ONLY WITH YOUR SPECIFIC AND SEPARATE CONSENT (Art. 6 para. 1 lett. a GDPR), for the following other purposes:

- Newsletters and/or invitations to events or subscribe you to events to which the Controller is a party or which it organises.

Processing may be carried out until the data subject's consent is revoked, and in any case for no longer than ten years.

Methods of Data Processing

The processing of your personal data is carried out by means of the operations specified in Art. 4 para.2 GDPR, namely: collection, recording, organisation, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, retrieval, alignment, use, combination, block, disclosure, erasure and destruction of data. Your personal data are subject to both paper and electronic and/or automated processing.

Access to data

Your data may be made accessible for the purposes of points A) and B) to:

- Employees and collaborators of the Controller, in their capacity as persons in charge of processing and/or system administrators;
- Third parties (e.g. suppliers, credit institutions, professional firms, etc.) carrying out activities on behalf of the Controller, in their capacity as external data processors.

Data Communication

Without your express consent, the Controller may disclose your data for the purposes set out in point A) to Supervisory Bodies, Judicial Authorities, as well as to all parties to whom disclosure is mandatory by law for the fulfilment of said purposes. Your data will not be disseminated.

Transfer of Data Outside the EU

The Data Controller does not directly transfer any data outside the European Union.

Nature of data provision and consequences of refusal to respond

The provision of data for the purposes set out in point A) is mandatory. In their absence, we shall not be able to guarantee the services you are using.

The provision of data set out in point B), on the other hand, is optional. You may then decide not to provide any data or to deny the possibility of processing data already provided at a later stage: in that case, you will not be able to receive e-mail invitations to events, newsletters. In any case, you will continue to be entitled to the services set out in point A).

Rights of the data subject

In your capacity as data subject, you have the rights set out in Art. 15 GDPR, namely:

- i. Obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning you, even if not yet recorded, and its communication in intelligible form;
- ii. Obtain information on: a) the origin of personal data; b) the purposes and methods of processing; c) the logic applied in the event of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments; d) the identification data of the data controller, data processors and the designated representative in the territory of the State, data processors or persons in charge of processing;
- iii. Obtain: a) the update, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data; b) the deletion, transformation into anonymous form or block of data processed in breach of the law, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed; c) certification to the effect that the operations set out in letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the parties to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the protected right;
- iv. To object, in whole or in part: a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning you, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection; b) to the processing of personal data concerning you for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for the performance of market research or commercial communication surveys, by means of automated calling systems without the intervention of an operator, by e-mail and/or by traditional marketing methods via telephone and/or paper mail. Please note that the data subject's right to object, as set out in point b) above, for the purposes of direct marketing by automated means extends to traditional marketing and that, in any event, the data subject's right to object may also be exercised in part. Therefore, the data subject may decide to receive only communications by traditional methods or only automated communications or neither.

Where applicable, you also have the rights set out in Art. 16-21 GDPR (Right to rectification, right to be forgotten, right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, right to object), as well as the right to complain to the Data Protection Authority.

Methods of exercising rights

You may exercise your rights at any time by sending:
